

**B.A. (Regular) Three Year Degree Programme in History under CBCS,
Gauhati University,**

Course Specific Outcome

Programme	History of India from the Earliest Times up to 1206 A.D.
Semester I His-RC-1016	The course covers the period from the earliest times up to 1206 A.D. The course explains the emergence the earliest civilizations of India viz. Indus Valley Civilization and Vedic Civilization . It also explains the emergence of the state system and rise of powerful states of Northern India. The course helps the students in attaining knowledge about the development of important state structure and state formation in South India in early period. The course is beneficial to the students in understanding the changes and transformation in policy, economy, society and religion in early India and the linkages developed through contacts with the outside world.

Programme	History of India from c. 1206 to1757
Semester II His-RC-2016	The course deals with the political history of India with the foundation of the Sultanate in Delhi till the disintegration of the Mughal Empire. Upon completion of this course, students will be able to analyse the political and social development in India between 1206-1757. The students will be able to explain the formation of different states during this period along with their administrative apparatuses, and the society, economy and culture of India in the 13 th to mid 18 th century period.

Course Specific Outcome

Programme	History of India (c. 1757-1947)
Semester III His-RC-3016	The course covers the period from the establishment of the British rule in India till the attainment of India's Independence. Upon completion of this course, students will be able to understand the major events of colonial rule. They will be able to identify the process of the growth of the resistance against the British colonial rule and the eventual growth of the Indian nationalist movement, which ultimately led to the end to the British rule in the country.
Programme	Social and Economic History of Assam
Semester-IV His-RC-4016	The course explains the socio-economic history of Assam in early, medieval and colonial period. It includes the development of cast system, religious beliefs, agriculture and land system, social organization, trade and commerce of the period under review. The course also helps the students in understanding various agricultural regulations, plantation economy, development of modern industries , transport system, education, the emergence middle class, development of art, literature and press and growth of public association.

Course Specific Outcome

Programme	History of Assam from the earliest times to 1826
Semester V His-RE-5016	The paper deals with a general outline of the history of Assam from the earliest times to the advent of the British to this land. On completion of this course, students will be able to identify major courses of development in the political history of Assam from the earliest times to the occupation of Assam by the English East India Company in the first quarter of the 19 th century. In addition to the political history the students will be able to learn the system of administration during the period under review.

Programme	History of Europe (1648-1870)
Semester V His-RG 5016	The paper deals with the political history of Europe for a period of two hundred years. After completion of this course the students will be able to learn the emergence of state system in Europe and the rise of modernity. They will also be able to analyse the revolutionary upheavals of Europe and finally shaped the world. They will be able to learn the transition of political history of Europe from the system of absolute monarchy to a form of parliamentary Government.

Programme	History of Assam (c 1826-1947)
Semester VI, HIS-RE-6016	The paper deals with the political history of Assam from the establishment of the British rule to the attainment of Independence in 1947. Upon completion of this course, students will be able to describe the period of British rule in Assam. They will also be able to understand the development of nationalism in Assam and its role in India's freedom struggle. The course would enable the students to analyse the main currents of the political and socio-economic development in Assam during the colonial period.

Programme	History of Europe (c 1870-1939)
Semester VI, His-RG- 6016	The course deals with the major political events in Europe from 1870 to the outbreak of the II world war in 1939. After completing the course the students will be able to explain how the rise of two unified nations Germany and Italy gave rise to intense imperialist contest the world over. The course would also be enable the students to analyze the causes and consequences of world war I and the developments leading to world war II
